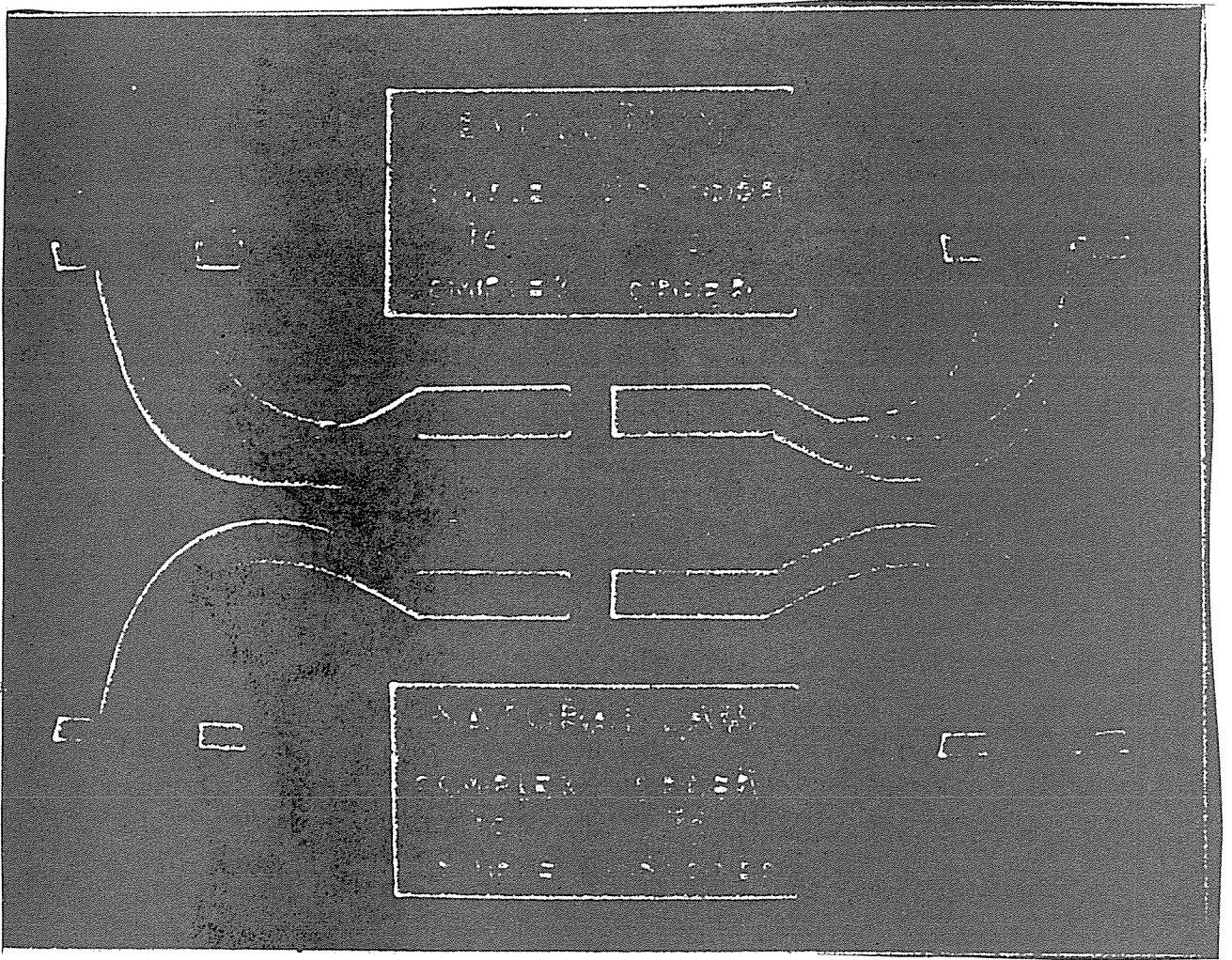
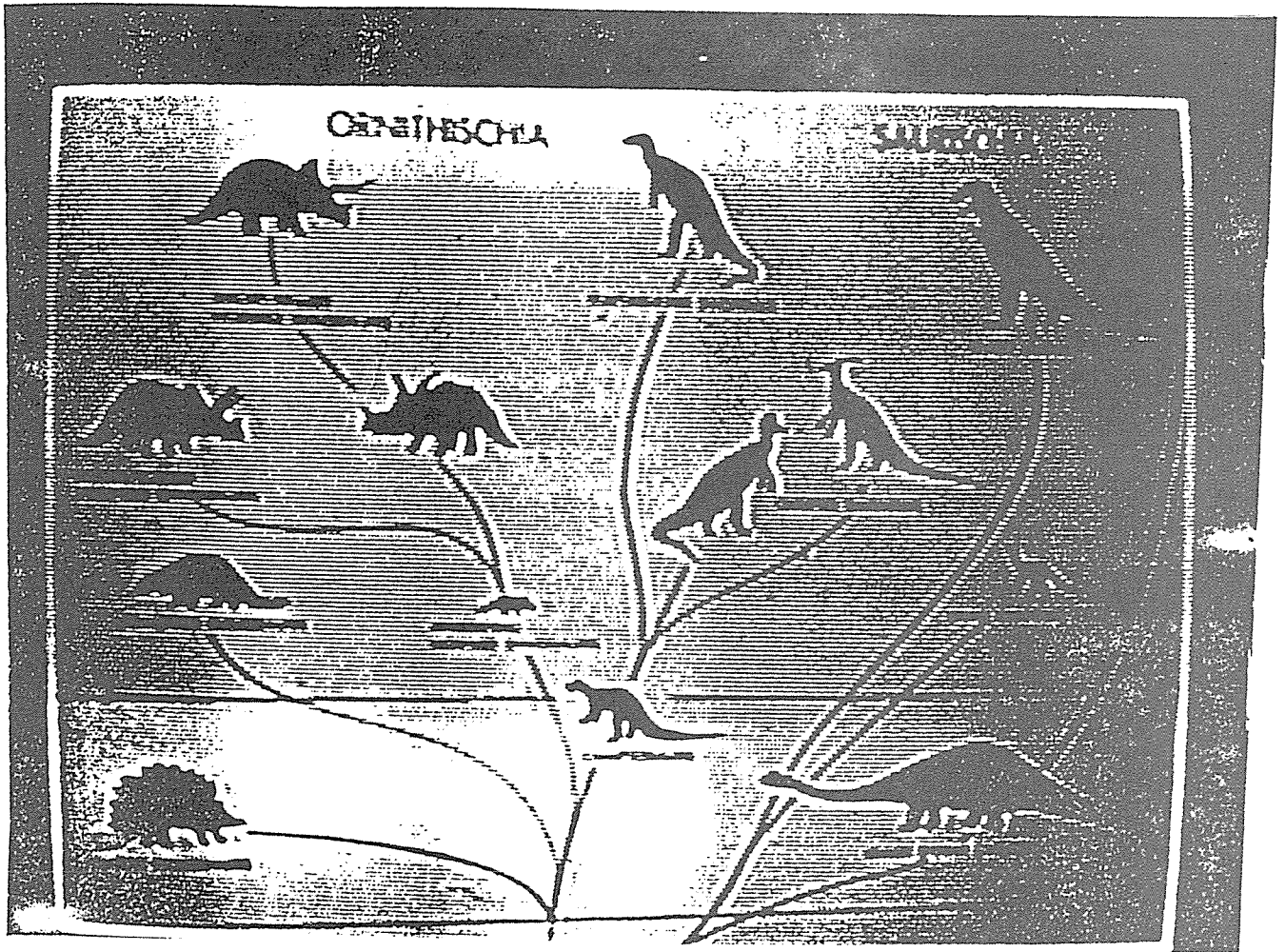

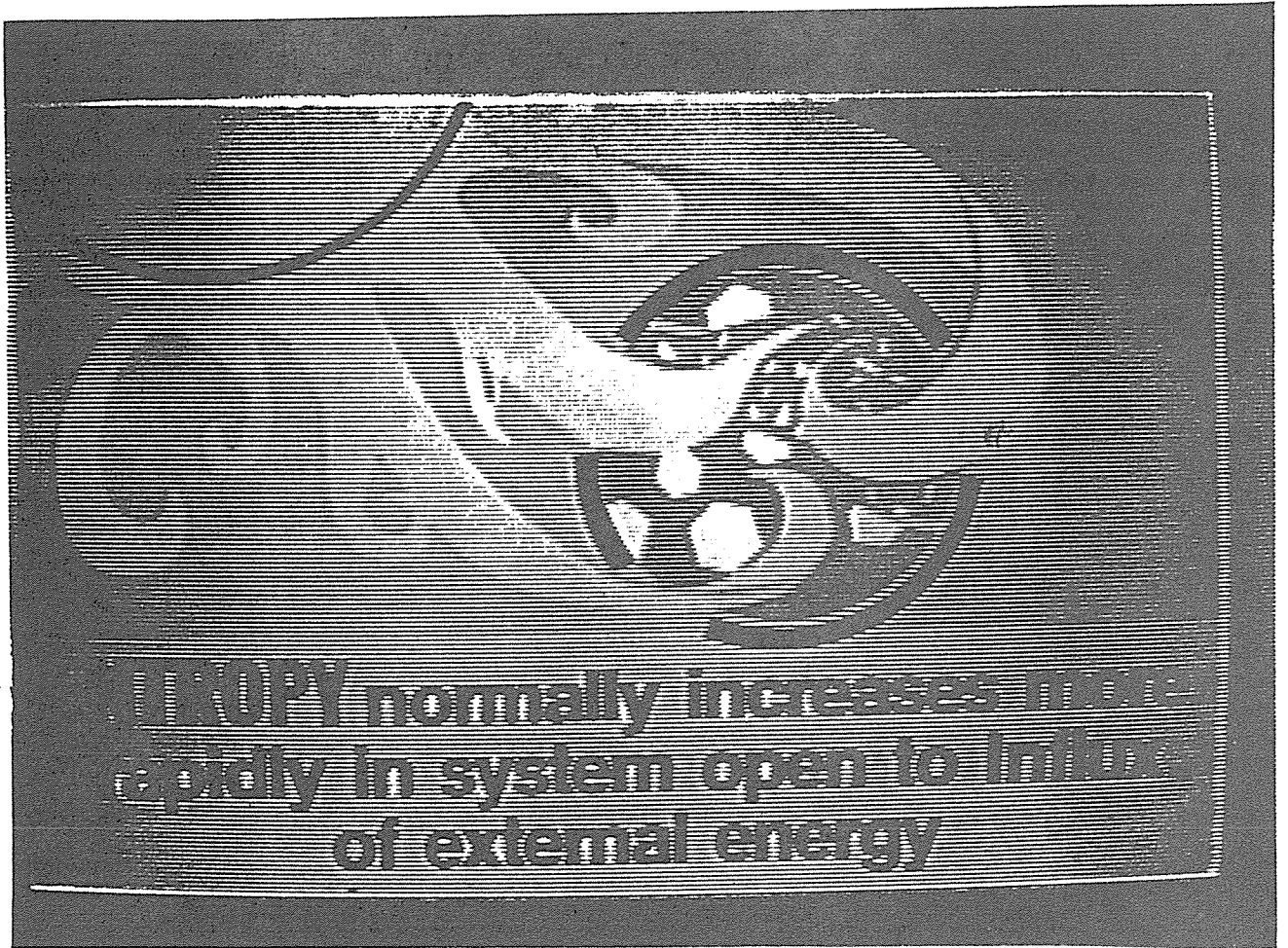
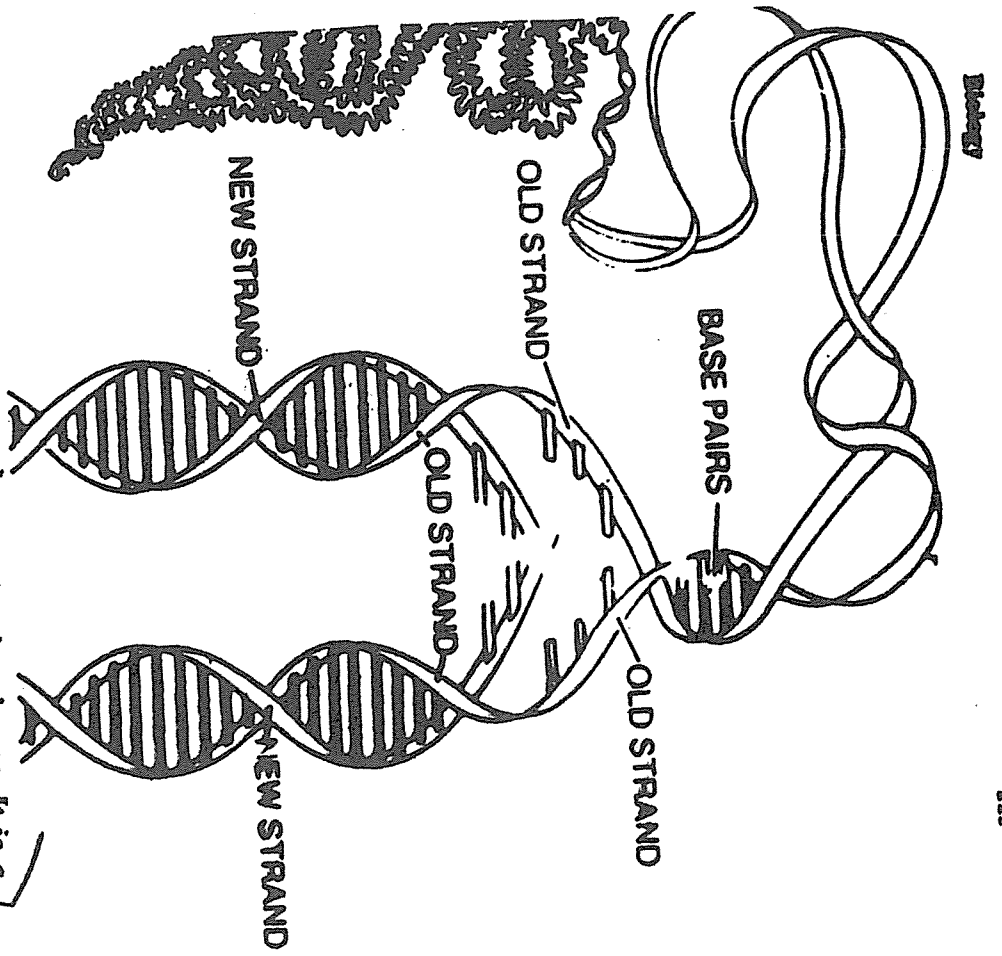
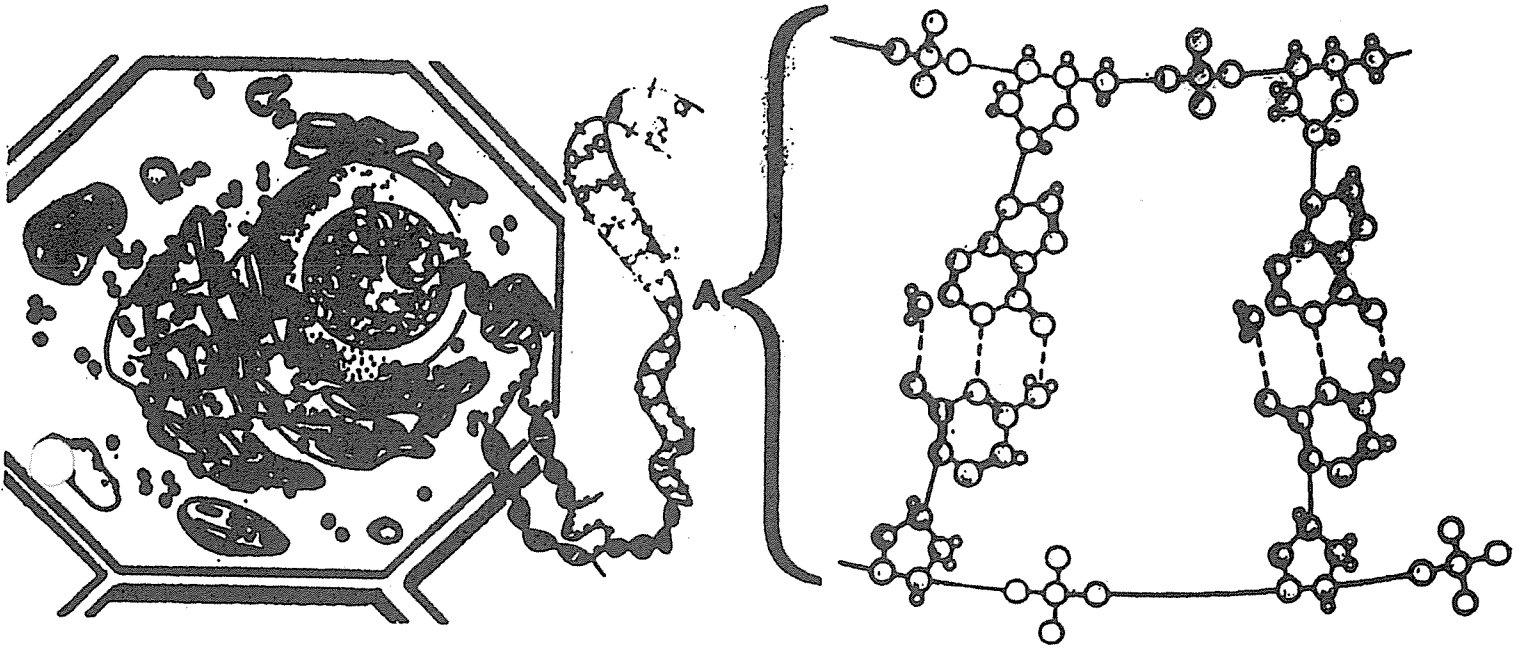


Figure 51. THE CHANCES OF CHANCE PRODUCING DNA

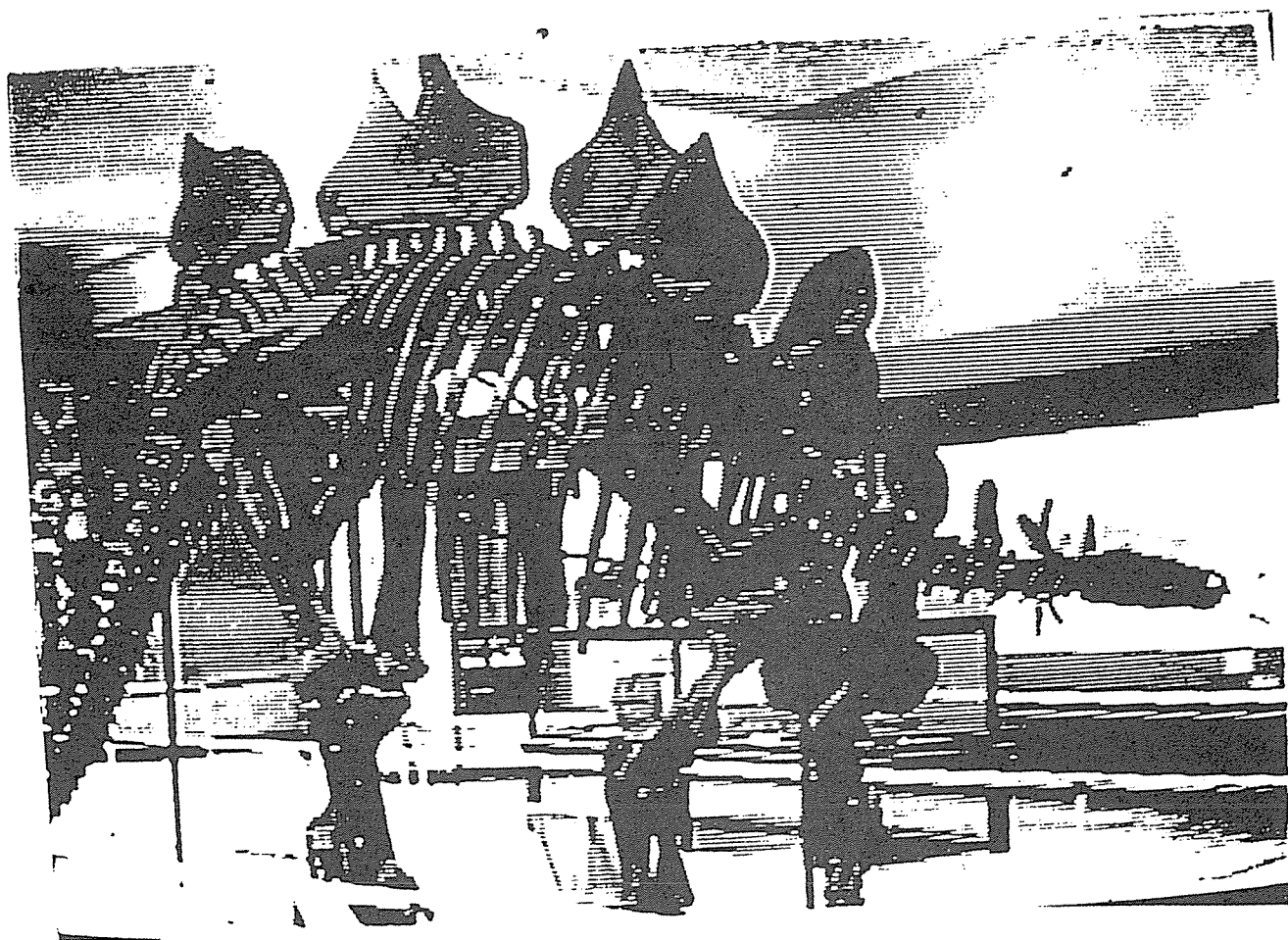
